A commonly cited triad for the diagnosis is amenorrhea, hypergonadotropism, and hypoestrogenism. If it has a genetic cause, it may be called gonadal dysgenesis.. The term "primary ovarian insufficiency" was first used in 1942 by Fuller Albright who first described

the condition.
